This position's responsibilities include creating, organising, and coordinating engaging activities for campers, brainstorming and/or developing new programs, implementing and carrying out camp rules, offering emotional support, and supervising campers.

Counsellors must ensure campers are safe, engaged, and having fun at all times while providing a positive attitude and comforting environment for campers to excel and feel encouraged to learn new skills for their academic success.

Key responsibilities are as follows:

- Supervise campers and ensure their safety at all times
- Lead group activities and team-building exercises
- Develop and implement daily schedules and plans
- Communicate effectively with campers, parents, and other staff members
- Attend staff meetings and participate in ongoing training sessions
- Manage disciplinary issues and conflicts that may arise
- Maintain cleanliness and organization of the campsite
- Prepare and serve snacks and meals to campers
- Provide First Aid or CPR when necessary
- Ensure compliance with all camp policies and procedures
- Other duties as assigned by the Camp Director

A great candidate for this position will possess the following:

- Must be 15+ years of age
- Being Bilingual is an asset
- CPR-C + AED certification is required
- At least 1 year of experience working with children
- Experience working in education such as tutoring
- Strong communication skills and communicate well with multiple stakeholders such as parents, staff, and children
